

## **HOME HEALTH CARE PROVIDER OR PRIVATE**

You and your loved ones have decided that additional assistance is needed in the home, hospital, assisted living facility or even nursing home. Its time to hire a caregiver/nurse and the dilemma arises. What is the best scenario for your individual need?

### PRIVATE CARE:

- A lower rate
- The patient is solely responsible for the hiring and/or firing, including taxes
- Lack of supervision, training and reporting

- Higher risk of fraud, neglect and exploitation

### HOME HEALTH CARE PROVIDER (HHCP):

- All caregivers must be licensed and bonded
- Caregivers and nurses are readily available  
(Over 2,000 caregivers and nurses to chose from)
- Level 2 background screening is run on all caregivers/nurses prior to working  
(with fingerprints to the FBI)
- RN assessment completed prior to services to determine your medical needs.
- Caregivers/nurses are chosen based on your individual needs
- No money exchanges hands between client and aide. HHCP takes care of all financial arrangements
- We do the leg work on selecting the individual but you still make the decision on who is hired
- Patient has a choice to bring in their own caregiver once she passes our background screening and intensive training
- On-going CNA/HHA supervision and training
- Certified Care Manager or Registered Nurse on call 24hrs/day 7days/week
